Seven Deadly Sins



Inspired by actual cases, each episode is based on one of the seven deadly sins: lust, gluttony, greed, sloth, wrath, envy, and vanity.

A serial killer performs his deadly rituals out of simple greed. Vanity lies behind an innocent young schoolgirl losing her life. Unable to stop eating, a dreadfully obese woman fatally falls prey to gluttony. Envy provokes the poisoning of unsuspecting victims and uncontrollable wrath leads to manslaughter.

What could cause such a horrific turn of events? Scientists, investigators and profilers have come to the conclusion that the deadly sins stand for human characteristics and are often the leading motives for horrible murders and tragic incidents.
